WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge offers several instructional athletic programs for young people in the summer months; and

WHEREAS: These programs have benefited the young people of Cambridge through the introduction of such sports as basketball, baseball and golf and the teaching of fundamentals and rules for these sports; and

WHEREAS: Although many of our young people have shown a strong interest in tennis, as the success of the Cambridge Rindge and Latin Tennis exemplifies, there exists no instructional tennis program for our young people in the summer; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has a number of tennis courts around the city that could be utilized for such a program; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager work with the Recreation Department to develop an instruction tennis program for the young people of Cambridge beginning in the summer of 2001; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council at the December 4, 2000 meeting what actions have been taken to implement this program.
