AN ACT ^{Head Telephone Operator} Placing The Offices Of ~~Telephone Supervisor~~ And Telephone Operator The Municipal Employment Of The City Of Cambridge Under The Civil Service Law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Head Telephone Operator

SECTION 1. The positions of ~~telephone supervisor~~ and telephone operator in the municipal employment of the City of Cambridge had upon the effective date of this act, be subject to the civil service law and rules; provided, however, that the incumbents of said offices on said effective date shall be subjected to a non-competitive qualifying examination for said office by the division of Civil Service. If said incumbents pass said examination, they shall be certified for said office and shall be deemed to be permanently appointed there to without serving any probationary period and their tenure of office shall be unlimited, subject, however to the provisions of said law. If one or both fails to pass said examination they shall continue to serve in said office, but shall not be subject to said civil service law and rules.
