RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby records its approval of a broad-based Historic Basin Citizens' Advisory Committee for this project to consist of municipalities abutting the basin, affected institutions, representatives of abutting neighborhoods, and representatives of the major user groups: walkers, runners, bicyclists, and skaters; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council urges that the appointment of this advisory committee be made expeditiously as the planning for restoration is already well under way; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to David Balfour and all members of the MDC Commission as well as to members of the Cambridge legislative delegation on behalf of the entire City Council.
