WHEREAS: Registered voters in Cambridge are entitled to be listed by the address where they live in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Registered voters in twelve buildings are reported to have been taken off the voter street list; and

WHEREAS: The Election Commission has had difficulty under current state law, collecting and updating the names of tenants in these buildings; and

WHEREAS: Appropriate measures need to be taken to avoid such administrative error; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council requests that the City Manager, in working with the Election Commissioners, devise creative and alternative ways to record the names of registered voters in cases which the condominium officers or tenant representatives are not compliant with state law and to report back in one week.
