Adopted by the affirmative vote of eight members.

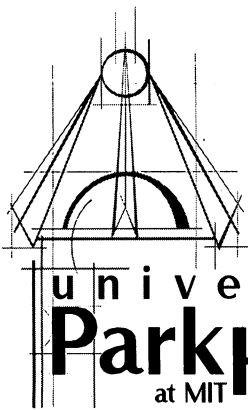
