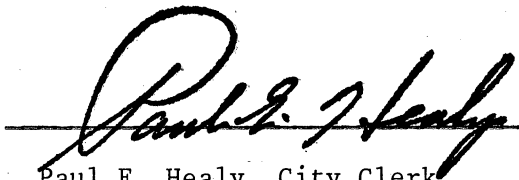
COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI
