

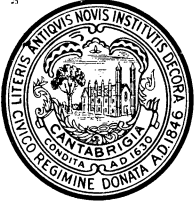


Dear Sir:
