## AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an ordinance formerly entitled "The General Ordinance of the City of Cambridge" as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge".

*Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:*

1. In Chapter Seventeen, entitled "Public Works", Sec. 17-72 "Definitions" is hereby amended by adding the following new definition of "fast food establishment":

"Fast food establishment" shall mean an establishment whose primary business is the sale, for consumption on or off the premises, of food which is (a) primarily intended for immediate consumption rather than for use as an ingredient in or component of meals; (b) available upon a short waiting time; and (c) packaged or presented in such a manner that it can be readily eaten outside the premises.

2. In said Chapter, Sec. 17-75 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new subsection 17-75 (c)(3):

"(3) Fast food establishments shall maintain authorized litter receptacles for the use of the general public outdoors on private property or on the adjoining sidewalk in a manner not to inconvenience pedestrians. Said establishments shall cause the receptacles to be emptied regularly."
