In Board of Aldermen, October 6th 1869

The Committee on Roads and Bridges, on the part of this Board, to whom was referred the petition of J. H. Langdon et al. that the sidewalk may be widened on the East side of Prospect St from Austin to Hampshire St in order to save a line of shade trees would report that they have considered the same. They find that most of the trees at the place mentioned are considerably out of the line of the sidewalk some as much as three and one half or four feet. To change the line of the sidewalk ^{sufficiently} to save these trees would leave a very wide sidewalk and destroy the beauty of the whole street. Your Committee therefore recommend that the edgestone be set so as to conform to the line of the street and that the trees be left for the future action of the City Government.
