In Board of Aldermen, May 18. 186 1870.

Whereas it is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Essex Street should be widened, between Clewin Street and Austin Street.

Ordered, That said Essex Street be widened on its North westerly side by taking a strip of land ten feet in width, belonging to Robert Longloss, Edward Hyde, and William J. Clewin, and extending from Clewin Street to Austin Street, and on the South Easterly side by taking so much of the land of Josiah W. Cook, Martin Whiting, and Thosca Spruce, as is included between the present line of said Essex Street and a line drawn parallel with said present line, at such distance South Easterly thereof, as to make said Essex Street thirty-one feet in width, except at the junction of Essex Street and Austin Street, where said new line unites with the line of Austin Street upon a curve of twenty feet radius, - all as delineated on a Plan drawn by J. G. Chase, City Engineer, dated Aug. 17. 1864, and now before this Board.

in which I lay the lines of said Essex
street, as widened, are shown by the blue
lines: - and that the land so taken be laid
out as a part of said Essex street, and a
public way.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said
widening, be estimated and awarded as follows: -

To Robert Longloss,	\$400.00
" Edward T. Ayer,	450.00
" William J. Cleverly,	588.00
" Hosea Spencer,	128.40
" Eleazer Whitney,	20.25
" Josiah W. Cook,	68.25

Ordered, That sixty days be allowed to the
persons above named for the removal of their
fences and other property standing on the
land so taken as aforesaid.
