Ordered, That, of the sum of Twenty-eight-Dollars and Fifty-five cents assessed upon the Monroe Heris, Dec. 27. 1845: to defray in part, the expense of completing a Sidewalk on Wall Street: the sum of Fourteen Dollars and Twenty-eight-cents be abated, the same having been paid by the present-owners of a part of the property assessed.
