ORDERED:

That in addition to the amounts previously appropriated the sum of Twenty Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$20,600,000.00) be and hereby is appropriated for the following purpose: For the taking of land by eminent domain in accordance with General Laws, Chapter 43, Section 30; Chapter 40, Section 14; and Chapter 79 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth, and for the construction, renovation, reconstruction and site development, including architectural, engineering and legal fees, and for the original equipment and furnishings, whether movable or built in, to complete said projects, and be it further

ORDERED:

That a City debt be created in the amount of Twenty Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars \$20,600,000.00 under the authority of the Acts of 1948, Chapter 645, as amended, and from time to time as the City Treasurer may deem necessary bonds of the City be issued not exceeding in the aggregate said sum of Twenty Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$20,600,000.00) either in the form of registered or coupon bonds. Indebtedness under this order shall be in excess of the statutory limit, said bonds to be payable in accordance with the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 19, so that the whole loan shall be paid in not more than twenty years from the date or dates of the bonds issued; that the City Manager, City Treasurer and City Auditor be and hereby are authorized and instructed to sign and execute said bonds and all transfers and exchanges of same in the manner directed by the Ordinances of the City of Cambridge and that the City Treasurer be and hereby is directed to bargain and sell and hereby is authorized to transfer and exchange the same.

Passed to a second reading at the meeting of the City Council held on April 28, 1975 and on or after May 19, 1975 the question may be on adoption.

That in addition to the amounts previously appropriated the sum of Twenty Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$20,600,000.00) be and hereby is appropriated for the following purposes: For the acquisition by purchase, taking by eminent domain or otherwise of certain land for off-street parking purposes, in connection with the proposed new Secondary Schools project, as described in an Order of the City Council dated April 28, 1975, and for the construction, original equipping and furnishing of additions to the secondary schools in the City and the reconstruction, remodeling, rehabilitation and modernization or portions of the existing secondary schools, including site development, architectural, engineering and legal fees and other costs incidental and necessarily related thereto, and be it further

ORDERED:

That to meet the aforesaid appropriation a City debt be created in the amount of Twenty Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$20,600,000.00) under the authority of the Acts of 1948, Chapter 645, as amended, and from time to time as the City Treasurer may deem necessary bonds of the City be issued not exceeding in the aggregate said sum of Twenty Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$20,600,000.00), said bonds to be payable in accordance with the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 19, so that each issue thereof shall be paid in not more than twenty years from its date; that the City Treasurer, City Manager and City Auditor be and hereby are authorized and instructed to sign and countersign said bonds and all transfers and exchanges of same in the manner directed by law and the Ordinances of the City of Cambridge and that the City Treasurer be and hereby is directed to bargain and sell and hereby is authorized to transfer and exchange the same.
