Subject History Station Grants

The Historical Commission has recently received four grants in support of its History Station program. These are as follows:

Massachusetts Bicentennial Commission	\$14,220
East Cambridge Savings Bank	2,000
Middlesex Bank	1,000
Shawmut County Bank	500
	<u>\$17,720</u>

This project involves the design and erection of History Stations in four locations throughout the city: Harvard, Central, and Porter Squares, and in East Cambridge. These facilities will contain several large sculptural units bearing interpretive panels on Cambridge history, and will be installed over a six month period beginning this summer.

The Bicentennial grant is in support of the entire program, while the donations from the banks are earmarked for the East Cambridge History Station.

As the funding sources have already committed themselves to these projects, we are anxious to proceed. If there are questions or if you wish me to appear before the Council when they consider acceptance of these grants, please let me know.

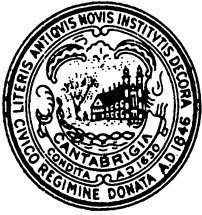


