- WHEREAS: Helicopter traffic over Cambridge neighborhoods is increasing; and
- WHEREAS: The Hyatt Hotel has begun to operate a helipad and other hotels have inquired about also doing so; and
- WHEREAS: A number of Cambridge residents are concerned about safety and noise issues relative to helicopters; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge has no zoning regulations in place regarding helipads; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager take the necessary steps to assure the safety and comfort of Cambridge citizens including the following:
- 1) Urge the FAA and Massport to assure that helicopter traffic routes not pass over Cambridge neighborhoods;
 - 2) Direct Community Development to prepare zoning legislation relative to helipads;
 - 3) Alert the License Commission to the nuisance at times posed by helipads;
 - 4) Ask the Mass. Aeronautics Commission to limit the number of flights from Cambridge helipads; and,
 - 5) Alert the Cambridge legislative delegation to concerns of residents about helicopters.
