## An Ordinance

In addition to the ordinance in relation  
to Health.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City  
of Cambridge, as follows:-

Section 5.<sup>th</sup> of the "Ordinance of the City of Cam-  
-bridge in relation to Health" is hereby amend-  
-ed, by the addition of the following clause to said  
Section-

" Any person who shall construct, main-  
-tain, or keep for use, a vault or privy con-  
-structed contrary to the provisions of this  
" section, shall forfeit and pay a sum not  
" exceeding twenty dollars for each and  
" every week during which <sup>such</sup> ~~the~~ vault or privy  
" so constructed shall be used."
