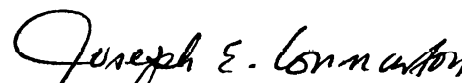

Re: *Additional Appropriation for the Law Department's Professional Services Account*

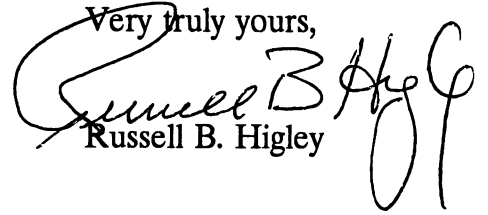
Dear Mr. Healy:

I request an additional appropriation of \$270,000.00 for the 610 - Professional Services Account for FY92. As you know, there has been a major lawsuit filed against the City making sweeping challenges against rent control. I estimate that we will need an additional \$50,000.00 to meet legal expenses in that case for the remainder of this fiscal year. We have also experienced greater than anticipated expenditures for outside counsel in the defense of City officials in the litigation surrounding the Commonwealth Day School, and I estimate that we will need an additional \$50,000.00 to meet expenses in that case. Finally, our expenses in complying with commitments made by the City in the Parking Freeze Ordinance, and in particular in developing technical and legal documentation for the purpose of proposing a SIP Revision, has exceeded expectations and I estimate that we will need an additional \$170,000.00 to meet those costs.

I have tried to maintain these estimates for additional monies at the lowest possible amounts. The \$270,000.00 additional appropriation is the lowest amount I can recommend

to you based upon current assessments.

I believe this additional amount is a prudent, well-justified additional appropriation.
