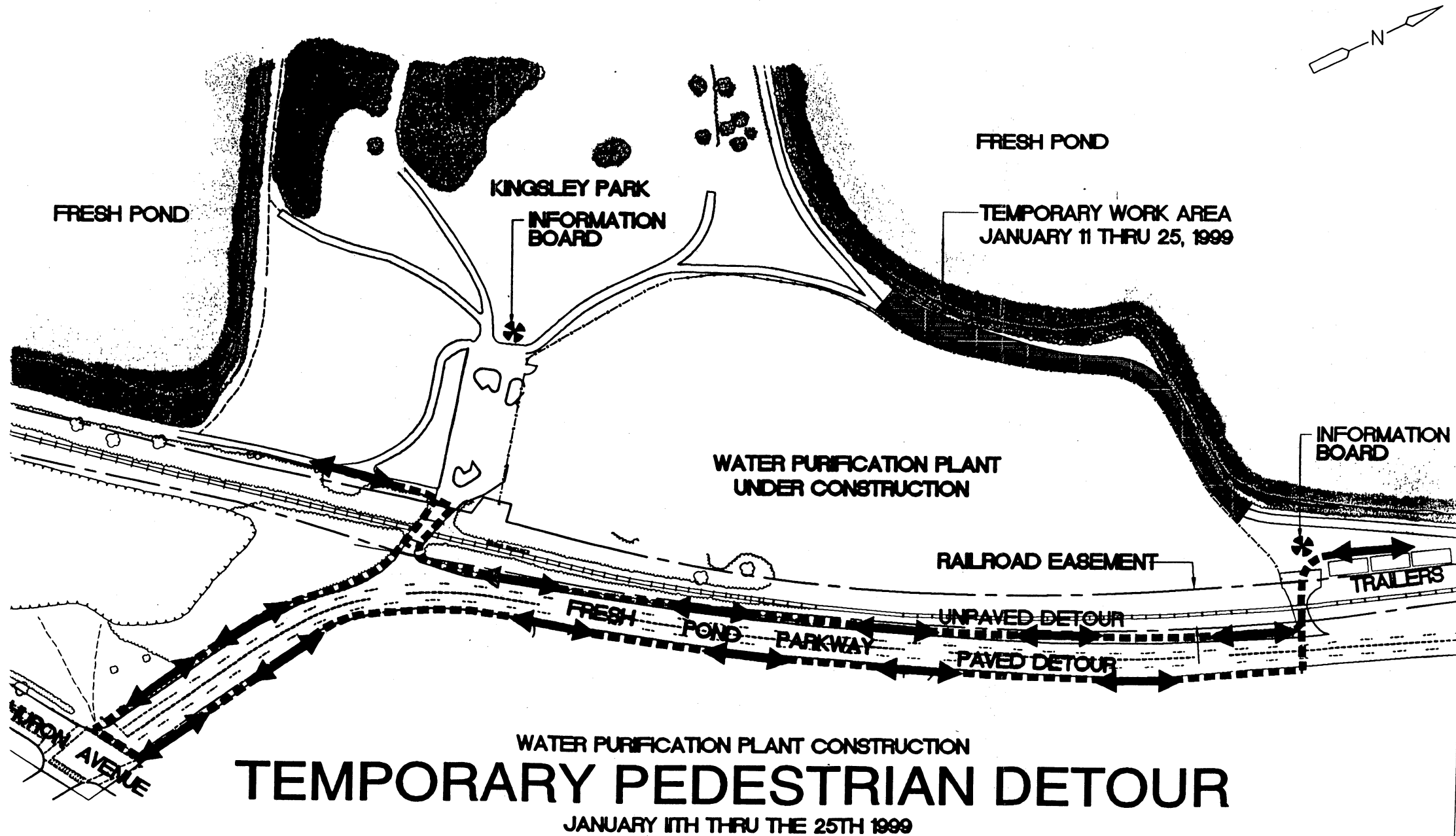

Pedestrian Detour

1. Approaching the water treatment plant from Lusitania Field, take a left at the sign to Fresh Pond Parkway. Either take a right turn and proceed south along an unpaved path along Fresh Pond Parkway to the Kingsley parking area or cross Fresh Pond Parkway and turn right on the paved sidewalk. Proceed south along Fresh Pond Parkway to Huron Ave and turn right across Huron Ave, right again and proceed north to Kingsley Parking area.
2. If approaching the water treatment plant from the south turn right at the Kingsley Parking area bridge. Either take the unpaved path along the east side of Fresh Pond Parkway and left at the construction trailers or proceed south to Huron Ave, turn left across Huron Ave and left again going north along Fresh Pond Parkway and left across Fresh Pond at the construction trailers.
