ORDERED:-

That the City Solicitor examine the proposed legislation for the extension of the Alewife Brook Parkway with particular regard to any restrictions that might be placed against commercial traffic on that part between Massachusetts Avenue and Concord Avenue; and enter a protest before the proper legislative committee against such restriction because it might retard the proper growth of a vast industrial area which has been so zoned by our city, which later may necessitate a duplication of expense to the city by the making of new roadways to this area.
