Orders - H. Davis

1. That the City Manager report to the CC on where drinking fountains will be placed around Fresh Pond when improvements are made to the reservation; Further that the CC supports the placement of drinking fountains around the perimeter of the pond.

2. That the CM direct the CDD to prepare a resolution for the City Council to members of Congress on limiting the size of trucks that are permitted to drive on city streets; Further that this resolution address any proposals to increase the size of trucks which will have use of all streets.

3. That the CM direct the DPW to place a trash barrel next to the bus stop at Lindstrom Field.

4. Whereas housing mediation programs that assist landlords and tenants at court house locations are the most successful in settling disputes and reaching harmonious resolution Whereas Cambridge does not have such a program at its disposal for the benefit of its landlords and tenants That the CM instruct the Law Department to send a letter urging that Judge Sherman establish or permit such a program at the Middlesex County Court House.

5. Whereas noise disputes are often contentious Whereas Cambridge's ethnic festivals are very valuable to celebrate Cambridge's diversity. Therefore that the CM ask the License Commission to establish a proactive process that brings sponsors of festivals and the community together to reach resolution on fair and equitable standards.
