

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, July 3^d 1872

Whereas;

On the 28th day of April 1869 an Order was adopted by this Board instructing the Superintendent of Streets to complete the Sidewalk on the northerly side of Main Street, from West Boston Bridge to the junction of Harvard and Main Street in Ward One, and thence upon the northerly side of said Harvard Street to Harvard Square, and Whereas, By a recent decision of the Supreme Court, there was held to be a technical informality in the assessment, inasmuch as Harvard and Main Streets were included in one assessment, and whereas certain parties having paid under protest, were held entitled to receive back the sums paid by them, and whereas they have therefore paid nothing towards the expense of said sidewalk,

Ordered, That the Superintendent of Streets be and hereby is instructed to remove all the brick from said Main Street sidewalk, in front of the Estates of Messers Arnold, Cushman, Richardson and Webber, and use the same on the sidewalk around the School House on the corner of Broadway and Innan Streets.
