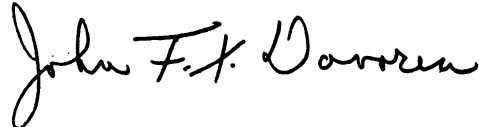

problems;

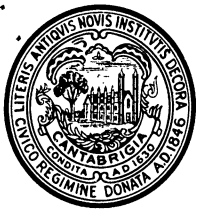
To give courses regarding women's health/ to advise and to provide informational materials to other persons giving such courses;
