- WHEREAS: He also shared his time to be of service in many civic, fraternal and Bar Associations and gave unstintingly of his time to his church, community and neighbors; and
- WHEREAS: He was honored by being selected by Governor Francis J. Sargent to serve as an Associate Justice of the Boston Municipal Court; now therefore be it

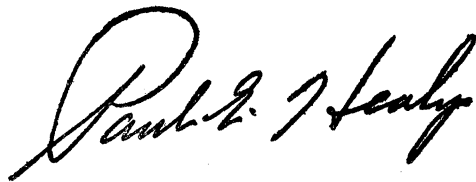
