Proposals for Teaming Gravel
for Stone Paving.

Sealed proposals will be received at this office until THURSDAY, April 28th, at 12 o'clock, noon, for teaming from the city gravel pits near Fresh Pond to Main Street, between Portland Street and the stone crossing leading from No. 506 Main Street, about 1500 cubic yards, more or less, of stone paving gravel, as required by the Superintendent of Streets, and to his satisfaction.

Separate proposals will also be received as above stated for teaming from said gravel pits to Harvard Street, between Dunster and Row Streets, about 300 cubic yards, more or less, of stone paving gravel as aforesaid.

Bids will be received from such parties as may desire to furnish and deliver satisfactory paving gravel at the places above stated, at the cost of teaming, only.

Proposals to state the price per cubic yard for loading, hauling and delivering said gravel, as above stated, the same to be measured in the carts under the direction of the City Engineer where delivered.

A bond will also be required for the faithful performance of said contract in the sum of \$500, the same to be satisfactory to the Committee on Roads and Bridges.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals. Proposals must be marked "Proposals for Teaming Gravel for Stone Paving," and addressed to
