Petition of the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company for determination by the Department that public convenience and necessity require locations in a portion of a public street in the care and control of the Metropolitan District Commission in the City of Cambridge, namely, Msg. O'Brien Highway from present manhole 26/195 at Cambridge Street, northeasterly to East Street approximately seventy (70) feet of underground conduit, to be used for the transmission of intelligence by electricity as shown on a plan on file with the Department.
