- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that William Corcoran, a life-long Cantabridgian, will soon retire from the New England Telephone Company, completing thirty-six years of dedicated service; and
- WHEREAS: "Bill", as he is known by so many of his friends and associates, was raised in Cambridge and attended local schools prior to serving his country during World War II as a member of the United States Navy from 1943 to 1946; and
- WHEREAS: Upon his honorable discharge, Bill went to work for the New England Telephone Company on May 20, 1946 as a Central Office Repairman and worked in that position until December 2, 1951 at which time he was promoted to Switchman and on June 3, 1956 became a Supervisor and later a Telecommunications Instructor for the Company; and
- WHEREAS: Bill continued his rise up the career ladder, when on December 30, 1962 he was appointed Wire Chief and ten years later, Dial Administration Manager in 1972, working in that capacity until 1976 at which time he was appointed Network Manager, the position from which he will retire; and
- WHEREAS: Bill had many civic interests over the years and in 1962 he was recognized for his concern for the Cambridge Community by then City Manager John J. Curry, who appointed Bill as a member of the Civic Unity Committee, a group of private citizens charged with the responsibility of interacting with many different community groups, their concerns and needs; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations and best wishes to William "Bill" Corcoran as he completes thirty-six years of dedicated service with the New England Telephone Company; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Corcoran on behalf of the entire City Council.

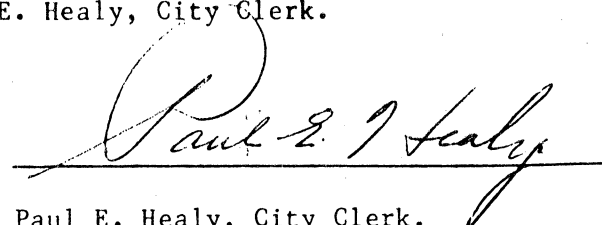
