- WHEREAS: Priscilla was a graduate of the Haskell School in Cambridge, as well as the Bennett School in Millbrook, New York and later taught an art appreciation program for fourteen years to residents of Cambridge housing developments; and
- WHEREAS: Miss Montgomery's work was frequently exhibited in the annual Phillips Art Show and she held a number of one-person shows, not only in Cambridge but throughout New England; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Miss Montgomery's brother, Hugh at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
