ORDERED:-

That the new public library located at the Charles E. Harrington School be and hereby is named the "Salvatore Francis Valente Memorial Library" in honor of Salvatore Francis Valente, to perpetuate his memory, and be it further

That a copy of this order be forwarded to the family of Salvatore Francis Valente.
