In Board of Aldermen, Feb. 15. 1871.

Whereas, in and by an Order adopted by the City Council, and approved by the Mayor, Dec. 17. 1870, - Seventeen hundred and forty-nine square feet of land belonging to Thomas G. Kent, Esq., of Helyard, were taken to widen Spruce Street, and by an inadvertence no damages were awarded to him therefor.

Ordered, That the sum of Fifty-two Dollars and Forty-seven cents be awarded to said Kent for his land so taken.
