Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$46,700.00 in the Grant Fund from the Executive Office of Communities & Development (\$38,000) and (\$8,700) from Corporate donations to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account \$31,400.00, Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$13,750.00 and Travel & Training Account \$1,550.00. This grant supports the Reclaim our Community (ROC) program and will provide funding for the Area IV Crime Task Force. The Task Force coordinates events and activities aimed at raising the level of neighborhood awareness and education with regard to crime and substance abuse issues.
