COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: It has been brought to my attention by some parents whose children attend the Bigelow Cooperative Daycare Center (affiliated with the Christ Church on Garden Street) that within the past two or three weeks, during the few minutes they need to drop off or pick up their children, an intensified effort has been undertaken to ticket their cars at parking meters along Harwell Place; and

WHEREAS: The center, in existence for 7 years, presently serves 40 children. During the seven years, until most recently, parents were not ticketed at the referenced location during these short parking periods; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Director of Traffic and Parking to review this concern and both assess the feasibility of providing a 10 or 15 minute grace period limited to the specific hours of drop off and pick up for vehicles displaying center-produced identification cards indicating that the owner/operator's child attends the center (presently possessed by all of them) and discuss the problem with the directors of the center; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on this matter by October 28, 1991, if at all possible.
