
I hereby ask for favorable consideration for a position on the Citizen Advisory Board for the Police Department. My qualifications for this position are as follows:

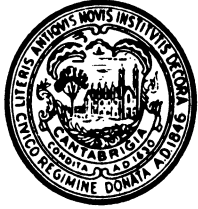
