Miss Maria L. Baldwin, for years well known and highly respected as Principal of the Agassiz School, has suddenly been called to her eternal reward, this Board desires, in recognition of her long and faithful service, to offer its tribute to her memory.

On graduating from the Cambridge Training School she began her career as a teacher in the old Agassiz School. Thirty years ago she became principal and continued in that capacity until her death on January 9th.
