SUBJECT: Parking in City Hall Well

This office has been in receipt of constant complaints from the Mayor and the City Council about illegal parking in the Handicapped Zone and the reserved spaces behind City Hall. Many of these complaints are the result of City Vehicles in these spots.

Effective immediately, no employee operating a City Vehicle shall park for any length of time in these spaces.

This includes Police and Fire Vehicles, unless they are responding to an alarm or call for service that is not administrative in nature.

All deliveries, mail pick-up or drop-off, or any other administrative functions shall be through the side door on Inman Street, which will be posted as a Loading Zone.

Violations of this policy will result in appropriate disciplinary actions, as well as immediate tagging and towing by the Police Department and Parking Control Officers. Department Heads are to notify supervisors/foremen of the action to be taken.
