The Committee on Roads and Bridges of this board, to which was referred the petition of H.B. Flint and others, praying that permission may be given them to coast on Arlington Street, - would herewith

Reply,

That the privilege asked for by the petitioners, cannot be granted, inasmuch as coasting in the public streets is expressly forbidden by an ordinance of the city. Section 31 of Chapter 36, of the Revised Ordinances, relating to the subject, is as follows:

"Section 31 No person shall behave himself in a rude or disorderly manner, or use any indecent, profane, or insulting language, in any street, lane, alley, or other public place, or near any building; or be or remain upon any sidewalk, or upon any doorstep, porch, or other projection from any such building, to the annoyance or disturbance of any person; nor shall any

person by any noise, gestures, or other means, wantonly and designedly frighten or drive any horse, in any street or other public place, no person shall play at football or any other game of ball, or "hurl", or fly kites, or balloons, or coast, or throw stones or snowballs, in any street lane or alley."

By the terms of the ordinance as above quoted, your Committee must recommend that the petitioners have leave to withdraw.
