In Board of Aldermen, Feb. 11, 1874,

Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be and hereby is authorized, and instructed to cause borings or such other examination as may be deemed necessary, to be made at the gravel bank on the 'Brastow Farm', so-called, in Waltham, with a view to providing a sufficient quantity of good material for street purposes for present and future necessities.

The expense thereof, not to exceed the
\$500, Sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to be charged to Appropriation for Streets and Paving.
