WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Ninth Street
from Pinney to Potter Street*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *fifty feet*
in width between *Pinney and Potter Street*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *J. H. Chase*
Civil Engineer, dated Sept. 30. 1882.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*
several owners and abutting having agreed in writing
to waive all claims for such damages.
