We the undersigned, abutters,
and tax payers of Spark St. do
hereby pray that your honorable
body, will take immediate action
and cause said St. to be accepted
as a public street from Mt. Auburn
to Brattle St. Which in our opinion
is in a proper condition for accept-
tance. this street is opened for
public travel for over twenty
years and the city have a common
sewer through this street. The upper
part of said street is accepted along
time, we cannot understand why this
part is not accepted before now. We
have conformed with rules and ^{regulations of the} City
Ordinance by procuring a plan of
said St and paid for it, which plan
we have left with Mr Chase at the
City Hall. Gentlemen they are a few of
us abutters that have kept this
street in repair for public travel
for the last sixteen years and recen-
tly we have graded it to some ex-
tent we cannot afford to spend any
more money on said street and
now at the present time there are
four grocery and provision stores
on this short St. The parties who
keep those stores and the customers
who patronize them suffer great
inconvenience. Gentlemen, we would
remind you of the necessity of a cess-
pool at corner of Spark and Mt.
Auburn St. which every stormy day
the overflow of water that comes down
Mt. Auburn and into Spark St. is
very disagreeable. And in conclusion
this being our fourth Petition and we
do earnestly hope that it will meet
the honorable board's approval.
