To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$10,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$9,000.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$1,000.00) from the Massachusetts National and Community Service Commission through the Massachusetts Department of Education. This grant will be used to organize a program to introduce young children to "computer basics." The classes will be taught by high school students assisted by two adult staff persons. Children participating in the classes will be selected from the Community School and Youth Programs in each of the five areas of the City and the Margaret Fuller House. This appropriation will cover the costs of the adult staff, a recognition event and administrative support for the grant.
