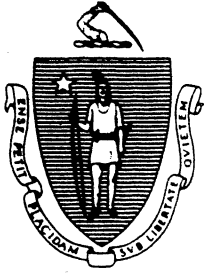

Application of Cambridge Electric Light Company, under the provisions of G.L. c. 164, §94G, as amended by St. 1981, c. 375, and the Company's tariff, M.D.P.U. No. 500, for approval by the Department of Public Utilities of a change in the quarterly Fuel Charge to be billed to the Company's customers pursuant to meter readings in the billing months of January, February and March, 1993.

Application is also made by Cambridge Electric Light Company for approval by the Department of rates to be paid to Qualifying Facilities for purchases of power pursuant to 220 C.M.R. 8.00 and M.D.P.U. No. 404. The rules established in 220 C.M.R. 8.00 set forth the filings to be made by utilities with the Department, and implement the intent of sections 201 and 210 of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978.

The Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing on the above-captioned application at its offices, Twelfth Floor, Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02202 on Wednesday, December 23, 1992 at 2:00 p.m.

The petitioner, Cambridge Electric Light Company, shall have on file with the Department for public inspection its calculations, data and reasons supporting its proposed fuel charge and proposed small power producer rates on and after December 16, 1992.

The petitioner is further required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least seven (7) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe.

The petitioner shall post by certified mail a copy of this notice and order, at least seven (7) days prior to the date of

hearing set herein, to all persons with whom the said Company has special retail contracts which do not incorporate a filed rate.

The petitioner shall notify all intervenors from the prior two fuel charge proceedings that it is proposing an adjustment to its fuel charge, and notify all intervenors of the date of the public hearing on the proposed fuel charge, at least ten days in advance of the public hearing.

The petitioner shall also provide the counsel of each intervenor from the prior two fuel charge proceedings with its fuel charge filing on the same day it is provided to the Department.

The Company shall also make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.
