WHEREAS: The Black Student Union takes great pride in the fact that it has always welcomed all individuals who believe that taking pride in the uniqueness of our many cultures is an ideal way to promote self worth and cultural unity; and

WHEREAS: Each year, the Black Student Union sponsors a number of school assemblies, among them a Kwanzaa assembly, celebrating the contributions of African American culture, and the Martin Luther King Assembly; raises funds for a scholarship program for graduating seniors; provides extensive materials on Black colleges; takes responsibility for promoting Black History Month within the community; and organizes the Annual Celebration of a People Banquet; and

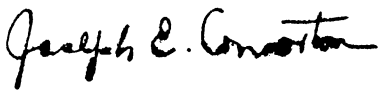
