- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the proper departments to look into the possibility of embarking on a similar program and report back to the City Council as soon as possible.

MBTA, city to clean up right-of-way

The MBTA, in cooperation with the City of Somerville's Office of Planning and Community Development, is scheduled to begin a clean-up of the Cedar Street to Grove Street Railroad Right-of-Way on July 5, 1988. The project will entail removing old railroad tracks, cleaning up debris, installing fencing and erect-

ing bollards and gates at the access and egress points. The project will take approximately 2½ to 3 months to complete.
