To the Honorable, the City Council:

I wish to advise your Honorable Body that I have this day appointed Joseph A. L. Medeiros, 168 Webster Avenue, Cambridge, as the fifth member of the Cambridge Community Schools Commission. Mr. Medeiros is a 27-year resident of Cambridge and is employed as an Evaluation Technical for the Polaroid Corporation.

Mr. Medeiros was one of the charter organizers of the Harrington Community Schools Council when it was activated in late 1969 and has been an active participant in the program since that time. He was one of the Community Schools representatives on the governing board of Recreation '70 and served as chairman of its Board of Trustees.

Mr. Medeiros is currently the lone candidate for the presidency of the Donnelly Field Planning Team, which is part of the Cambridge Economic Opportunity Program. He is married and has five children -- Roy (14), a ninth grader at St. Mary's; Karen (13), Lisa (11), Joseph (8), and Mark (3), all of whom, except for Mark, attend the Harrington School. Mr. Medeiros, whose parents came to this area from Portugal, has been active in local Portuguese affairs and is an active member in the Cambridge Organization for Portuguese Americans (C.O.P.A.).

As a member of the Community Schools Commission, he will share overall responsibility for the City-wide program with Chairman Oliver Brooks, Mrs. Doris Aubrey, Councilor Henry Owens III, and School Committeeman Peter Gessell.
