During the months when the motorcycles were out this use to be one of their assignments.



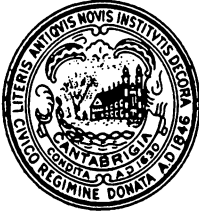

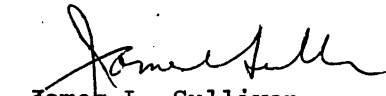
