- WHEREAS: The City of Boston has found their mounted police patrol to be of great value in excess of their original expectations, and
- WHEREAS: They have been used not only for civic and ceremonial display but also to form an important link in police patrol that is midway between foot patrol and car patrol, and
- WHEREAS: They provide excellent visibility from a distance, valuable crowd and traffic control, an excellent means of patrolling the parks and shopping areas as well as the neighborhoods, now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consult with the Chief of Police and report back to this Council within two weeks with a response to the proposal of instituting a pilot mounted police program in the City of Cambridge.
