IN CITY COUNCIL

October 15, 1979

WHEREAS:

William A. Mueller, a former employee of the Police Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Police Department on September 30, 1930 and was pensioned on January 28, 1968 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 83a, Sub-section A of the General Laws and died on March 20, 1979, having served not less than thirty-eight years; and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor his widow, Mrs. Mary H. Mueller, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by William A. Mueller, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Mary H. Mueller, widow of William A. Mueller, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.

Dear Mr. Sullivan:

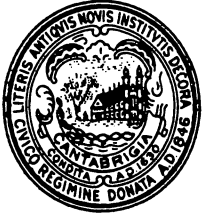


