my son, Jason L. Hazlett. His date of birth is August 6, 1981, he is 17 years old and a Senior at CRLS. He has a strong interest in Art and plans to make that his major in college. Jason has not yet chosen which school he would like to attend.

On May 15th, he will be presented with his Eagle Scout award. Jason has been in Scouting since he was 6 years old where he began as a Tiger Cub. Jason also plays hockey and starting skating at three years of age and playing from age 5 with Cambridge Youth Hockey. He has attended the Harrington School till 6th grade, Agassiz School for 7th & 8th grade and CRLS for four years. Jason has been a member of the Italian Club and has served as its treasurer for two years. He also belongs to the Bowling Club. He was on the varsity boy's ice hockey team all four years and helped them to two straight trips to the State Championships. Jason has been a GBL All-Star the past two years and this year, received the Coach's Award.

For his Eagle Service Project, Jason participated in the Monument Inscription Program at Mt. Auburn Cemetery. With a group of fellow Scouts, they documented the inscriptions, condition, designs and locations of the monuments at the Cemetery to preserve this information in their computer database before it is lost forever.
