- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened by the reports of the disaster in Bhopal, India resulting from poison gas leaks from the Union Carbide plant, causing the death of 2,000 people and lasting injuries to thousands of others; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council, on behalf of all citizens of the City of Cambridge, wishes to express to Arjun Singh the Chief Minister of the State of Madhya Pradesh their deepest sympathy at this great loss, and wishes to convey to Mayor R.K. Basara of Bhopal their offer of aid and assistance in this time of great trial; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That His Honor, the Mayor, Leonard J. Russell be and hereby is requested to convey the sentiments of this City Council to the Indian Consulate in Boston and further, that a copy of these resolutions be sent to Arjun Singh, the Prime Minister and Mayor R.K. Basara, to record our concern and offer of assistance in their hour of need.
