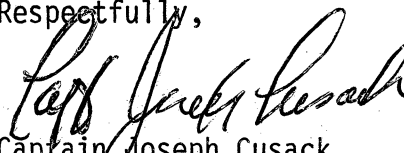
Dear Sir:

Subject City Council Order #3 of 6/7/82 "Parking Plan -Fresh Pond Reservoir"

A parking plan for the Fresh Pond Reservoir was designed and signs were posted last year prohibiting parking to those vehicles that do not have resident stickers. At that time the Traffic Department met with the Police Department and the Water Board to discuss their problems and to find ways to control this parking problem.

It was decided that the Water Board would approve the installation of signs stating the parking restriction and that the Police Department would have to enforce this ban.

It is my opinion that all that need be done is to have the Water Board ask the Police Department to enforce the parking restriction.

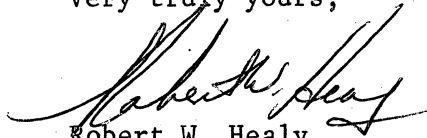
