Dear City Councilor:

I am writing to you today at the request of a number of Cambridge City Officials to inform you that our Third Annual Mini Grand Prix Event is scheduled for Saturday, September 28, 1996, rain date, Sunday, September 29, 1996, to benefit the Arthritis Foundation.

The Arthritis Foundation Mini Grand Prix is a "mini" version of the Grand Prix auto racing. The race course is designed with a variety of bends and hairpin turns that place a premium on maneuverability and acceleration. Obstacles are set up to challenge the drivers' skills and abilities.

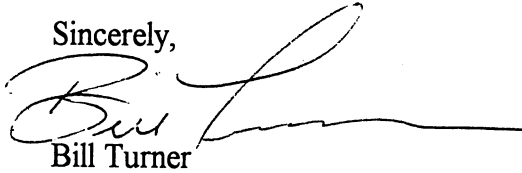
As last year, the event will offer a full day of mini racing, concessions and entertainment for the whole family, while cheering on their favorite racing team as they cross the finish line.

University Park will again be our site for this year's event. (see enclosed map) We have met with the Police, Fire, Public Works, MIT, Forest City Development and the Traffic Department. As the results of the meeting, the City Officials have given final approval for this year's permit.

This year, the Arthritis Foundation has awarded 1.8 million in research funding in Massachusetts of which Cambridge received nearly one half million dollars. Monies raised from the Mini Grand Prix Event will continue this research in Cambridge as well as other cities in Massachusetts.

The mission of the Arthritis Foundation is to continue its search for the causes, cures and preventions of arthritis for the 876,000 men, women and children with arthritis in Massachusetts.
