On January 18, 1973, the Housing Subcommittee held a public meeting to discuss the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority's plans for the development of the Kendall Square Urban Renewal Area. At this meeting many issues were raised and differences of opinion expressed concerning the CRA's proposals and their effects on the surrounding East Cambridge community. In view of the implications that the development of this site has for the City's tax and employment base, the Housing Subcommittee recommends that the City Manager direct the Department of Planning and Development to evaluate the plans proposed by the CRA for the surplus NASA land and the Golden Triangle. This evaluation should be completed and submitted to the City Manager within three weeks.
